### **Greek word studies**

### Foreknown, 20a

προγινώσκω [Strongs 4267] a combination of πρό [Strongs 4253] meaning "before, in front of, earlier than"; and γινώσκω [Strongs 1097] meaning "to know, recognize, experience". Therefore, προγινώσκω is "know beforehand, foreknow". This Greek word occurs 5 times in the New Testament. Acts 26:5, Romans 8:29, Romans 11:2, 1 Peter 1:20, 2 Peter 3:17.

### Foundation, 20a

καταβολή [Strongs 2602] another combination word from κατά [Strongs 2596] usually "according to", properly, "down from, from a higher to a lower plane, with special reference to the terminus or end-point" (J. Thayer); and βάλλω [Strongs 906] "cast, throw, place, put, drop." Therefore, Kαταβολή is "a foundation, deliberately laid according to a blueprint; a designer's plan, upon which the entire super-structure is purposefully built."

#### World, 20a

κόσμος [Strongs 2889] literally, "something ordered" or an "ordered system" such as the universe, all of creation. It can also mean worldly affairs, or the inhabitants of the world. It can also mean "adornment, fashion".

A common noun occurring 186 times in the New Testament, most frequently in John's writings. In Peter's writings, 1 Peter 1:20, 3:3, 5:9, 2 Peter 1:4, 2:5, 2:5, 2:20, 3:6. This word is transliterated as cosmos, but is usually translated as world.

### Revealed, 20b

φανερόω [Strongs 5319] meaning "to make visible, make clear, manifest, make known, make apparent, make plain". A verb occurring 49 times in the New Testament, but only twice by Peter. 1 Peter 1:20 and 1 Peter 5:4.

From  $\phi$ ως [Strongs 5457] meaning "light, a source of light, illumination, radiance". Hence  $\phi$ ανερόω means "to bring into the light in order to be clearly displayed". The active voice would be "to manifest" but the passive voice (as here in 1Peter 1:2

The active voice would be "to manifest", but the passive voice (as here in 1Peter 1:20) is, "to be manifested" To be manifested is more than to "appear." A person may "appear" in a false guise or without a disclosure of what he truly is. To be manifested is to be revealed in one's true character. (Vine)

This life [of Christ] which is invisible was made visible to the human race through the humanity of our Lord. We put light which is invisible through a prism, break it up into its component parts, and it becomes visible. The beauty of the life that God is, broken up into its various parts such as love, grace, humility, kindness, etc., is seen through the prism of the human life of our Lord. (Wuest)

Without question, this is the great mystery of our faith: Christ was revealed in a human body and vindicated by the Spirit. He was seen by angels and announced to the nations. He was believed in throughout the world and taken to heaven in glory. 1 Timothy 3:16

### Last 20b

ἕσχατος [Strongs 2078] "last, extreme, end, final." This word is the root of "eschatology" which is the study of last things, or end times. ἔσχατος is usually translated as last. But in these last days He has spoken to us by His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, and through whom He made the universe. Hebrews 1:2

Hebrews 9:26

1 Corinthians 10:11

1 Peter 4:7

#### Times, 20b

χρόνος [Strongs 5550] meaning "time, a particular time, time in sequence".

χρόνος [Strongs 5550] is distinct from καιρός [Strongs 2540] meaning "season, opportunity, occasion". For example, "It is not for you to know times [χρόνος] or seasons [χρόνος] that the Father has fixed by His own authority." (Acts 1:7)

### for your sake. 20b

δι' ὑμᾶς [Strongs 1223] διά a preposition meaning "through, on account of, because of, by reason of, for the sake of, because of." Properly, across to the other side. Plus the second person plural pronoun.

Stupendous words! This sense of their place in God's plan, their privileged status, along with their sense of the impending end, should strengthen these believers in the face of their trials. (Davids)

## Through Him, 21a

The words "through Him" appear in: Jn 1:3, Jn 1:7, Jn 1:10, Jn 3:17, Jn 14:6, Acts 2:22, Acts 3:16, Acts 7:25, Acts 10:43, Acts 13:38, 39, Ro 5:9, Ro 8:37, Ro 11:36; 1Co 8:6, Ep 2:18, Php 4:13, Col 1:20, Col 2:15, Col 3:17, Heb 7:25, Heb 13:15, 1Pe 1:2, 1John 4:9
The similar phrases, "through Whom", "through our Lord", etc, appear in: John 1:17, Acts 10:36, Ro 1:4, 5; Ro 1:8, Ro 2:16, Ro 5:1; Ro 5:2, Ro 5:11, Ro 5:21, Ro 7:25, Ro 16:27, 1Cor 15:57, 2Cor 1:5, 3:4, 5:18, Gal 1:1, Eph 1:5, Php 1:11, 1Th 5:9; Titus 3:6, He 1:2; He 2:10, Heb 13:21, 1Pe 2:5, 1Pe 4:11, Jude 1:25

## Believe, 21a; faith, 21b

πιστός [Strongs 4103] an adjective in 21a; πίστις [Strongs 4102] a noun in 21b. Faith is not a blind leap but is a confident commitment to One about Who abundant evidence bears ample testimony.

In 1 Peter 1:21a "believe" is  $\pi$ ιστοὺς, an accusative masculine plural adjective. An adjective without a noun for it to describe! Most translations treat it as a verb, "you believe". But a better translation would be you (plural pronoun) are faithful (descriptor of the pronoun).

### The foundation of the world

He was known before the **foundation of the world**, but was revealed in the last times for your sake. 1 Peter 1:20

Then the King will say to those on His right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the **foundation of the world**. Matthew 25:34

According as he hath chosen us in him before the **foundation of the world**, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love: Ephesians 1:4

And all who dwell on the earth will worship the beast—all whose names have not been written from the **foundation of the world** in the Book of Life belonging to the Lamb who was slain. Revelation 13:8

All who dwell on the earth will worship him, whose names have not been written in the Book of Life of the Lamb slain from the **foundation of the world**. Revelation 13:8 KJV

The beast that you saw--it was, and now is no more, but is about to come up out of the Abyss and go to its destruction. And those who dwell on the earth whose names were not written in the book of life from the **foundation of the world** will marvel when they see the beast that was, and is not, and yet will be. Revelation 17:8

Wording with similar thought to "foundation"

In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised **before the world began**; Titus 1:2

He has saved us and called us to a holy calling, not because of our works, but by His own purpose and by the grace He granted us in Christ Jesus **before time began**. 2 Timothy 1:9

## A model of the solar system

Let's try and put some perspective into what the Scripture tells us about the universe. We will start close to home. Here is a scale model of our solar system, based on the standard 30 cm (12 inch) globe found in many school classrooms.

- We start with planet earth floating in the vastness of space.
- Our nearest neighbour is the moon. Using our 30 cm globe as the standard, the moon will be only 8 cm in diameter and we will place it just over 9 metres away from the globe.
- Now we will place the sun. On the same scale as the earth and the moon, the sun will be
   33 metres tall (that is as high as a ten-story building), and will position it 3.5 kilometres away from our globe.
- Let's add the rest of the planets in the solar system. We will start with Mercury which is only 11.4 cm in diameter and is only 1.36 km from the sun.
- Venus is next. At 28.5 cm it is almost the same size as earth, and we will place it 2.5 km from our sun.
- We already have earth in place, so we turn to Mars which is a ball of only 16 cm. We will position it 5.3 km from the sun.
- Jupiter is the largest planet in our solar system. Using our scale, it is 3.35 metres across, and we need to locate it more than 18 km from our scale sun.
- Saturn is next. At 282.6 cm it is nearly 10 times bigger than earth. It's rings extend to 640 cm. Saturn sits 33.4 km from our model sun.
- Uranus is 123 cm across and circles our sun at a distance of 67 km.
- Neptune we will make 116.4 cm and place 105 km from our sun

- At only 5.4 cm, Pluto is our smallest 'planet'. It was only discovered in 1930. It swings out to a distance of 172 km from the sun.
- Just to complete the picture the nearest star, other than our own sun is Proxima
   Centauri and even to scale it is 940,046 km nearly a million kilometres away!

Then beyond all this there is the rest of our own galaxy. And then beyond even this, the Lord Jesus has sprinkled the universe with who knows how many other galaxies and constellations.

So, how vast is space and time?

Every person is a very small blip in time, on a very small rock in a very large universe. But every single one of us is known, and is special.

### Questions, with no wrong answers, to ask myself and others.

- 1. If you could ask God one question, knowing He would fully answer, what would you ask Him?
- 2. How do you feel, knowing the entire universe, God's work in history, and the whole plan of salvation, is "for your sake"?
- 3. Suggest some appropriate responses to Question 2.
- 4. Since God foreknew everything that was going to happen, why do you think He went ahead and make the world anyway?
- 5. Read Hebrews 1:2. When will the last days / end times begin? Read 2 Timothy 3:1-5. What will be the signs of the last days? How do you think we should conduct ourselves when the last days come?
