The sign of Jonah

The Gospels record Jesus speaking of the sign of Jonah on three separate occasions. Those three occasions are Matthew 12:39-40, Matthew 16:1-4 (=Mark 8:11-12), and Luke 11:29-30. The context for each reference is different, showing that Jesus pointed to Jonah as His sign on at least three separate occasions. The first reference includes Jesus' explanation of the sign of Jonah.

³⁹ Jesus replied, "A wicked and adulterous generation demands a sign, but none will be given it except the sign of the prophet Jonah. ⁴⁰ For as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of the great fish, so the Son of Man will be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth. Matthew 12:39-40

Those "three days and three nights" were the three Sabbath Days between the crucifixion and the resurrection. Those days in the tomb were the annual Sabbaths of Passover, and Unleavened Bread; and the weekly Sabbath. He rose on the Day of First Fruits.

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Commentary on signs

Signs in the Old Testament

The first sign was part of Creation

Then God said, "Let there be lights in the expanse of the heavens to separate the day from the night, and let them be for **signs** and for seasons and for days and years. Genesis 1:14

The second sign was for protection

So the Lord said to him, "Therefore whoever kills Cain, vengeance will be taken on him sevenfold." And the Lord appointed a **sign** for Cain, so that no one finding him would slay him. Genesis 4:15

The third sign was as a covenant of grace

¹² God said, "This is the **sign** of the covenant which I am making between Me and you and every living creature that is with you, for all successive generations. ¹³ I set My bow in the cloud, and it shall be for a **sign** of a covenant between Me and the earth… ¹⁷ And God said to Noah, "This is the **sign** of the covenant which I have established between Me and all flesh that is on the earth." Genesis 9:12, 13, 17

The fourth sign was between God and Abraham

And you shall be circumcised in the flesh of your foreskin, and it shall be the **sign** of the covenant between Me and you. Genesis 17:11

The exodus to Mt Sinai was a sign

And He said, "Certainly I will be with you, and this shall be the **sign** to you that it is I who have sent you: when you have brought the people out of Egypt, you shall worship God at this mountain." Exodus 3:12

The plagues on Egypt were all signs

⁸ "If they will not believe you or heed the witness of the first **sign**, they may believe the witness of the last **sign**. ⁹ But if they will not believe even these two **signs** or heed what you say, then you shall take some water from the Nile and pour it on the dry ground; and the water which you take from the Nile will become blood on the dry ground."... ¹⁷ You shall take in your hand this staff, with which you shall perform the **signs**."... ²⁸ Moses told Aaron all the words of the Lord with which He had sent him, and all the **signs** that He had commanded him to do.... ³⁰ and Aaron spoke all the words which the Lord had spoken to Moses. He then performed the signs in the sight of the people... ³ But I will harden Pharaoh's heart that I may multiply My **signs** and My wonders in the land of Egypt... ²³ I will put a division between My people and your people. Tomorrow this **sign** will occur."... ¹ Then the Lord said to Moses, "Go to Pharaoh, for I have hardened his heart and the heart of his servants, that I may perform these **signs** of Mine among them, ² and that you may tell in the hearing of your son, and of your grandson, how I made a mockery of the Egyptians and how I performed My **signs** among them, that you may know that I am the Lord." Exodus 4:8, 9, 17, 28, 30, 7:3, 8:23, 10:1, 2

The blood of the Passover was a sign

The blood shall be a **sign** for you on the houses where you live; and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and no plague will befall you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt. Exodus 12:13

The Feast of Unleaven Bread was a sign

So it shall serve as a **sign** on your hand and as reminders on your forehead, for with a powerful hand the Lord brought us out of Egypt. Exodus 13:16

Sabbaths / holy days are all signs

¹³ "But as for you, speak to the sons of Israel, saying, 'You shall surely observe My sabbaths; for this is a **sign** between Me and you throughout your generations, that you may know that

I am the Lord who sanctifies you... ¹⁷ It is a **sign** between Me and the sons of Israel forever; for in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, but on the seventh day He ceased from labour, and was refreshed. Exodus 31:13, 17

All miracles are signs

¹¹ The Lord said to Moses, "How long will this people spurn Me? And how long will they not believe in Me, despite all the **signs** which I have performed in their midst?...²² Surely all the men who have seen My glory and My **signs** which I performed in Egypt and in the wilderness, yet have put Me to the test these ten times and have not listened to My voice. ¹ The Pharisees and Sadducees came up, and testing Jesus, they asked Him to show them a **sign** from heaven... ³ And in the morning, 'There will be a storm today, for the sky is red and threatening.' Signs in the world, and in the church

¹³ He performs great **signs**, so that he even makes fire come down out of heaven to the earth in the presence of men. ¹⁴ And he deceives those who dwell on the earth because of the **signs** which it was given him to perform in the presence of the beast, telling those who dwell on the earth to make an image to the beast who had the wound of the sword and has come to life.
